

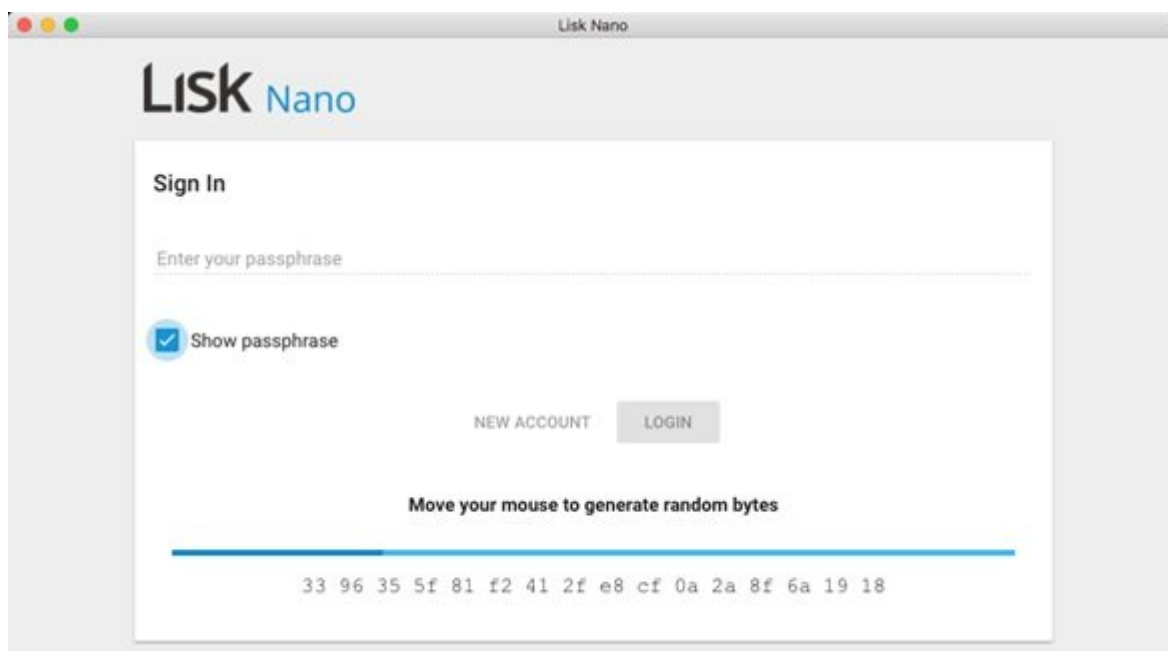

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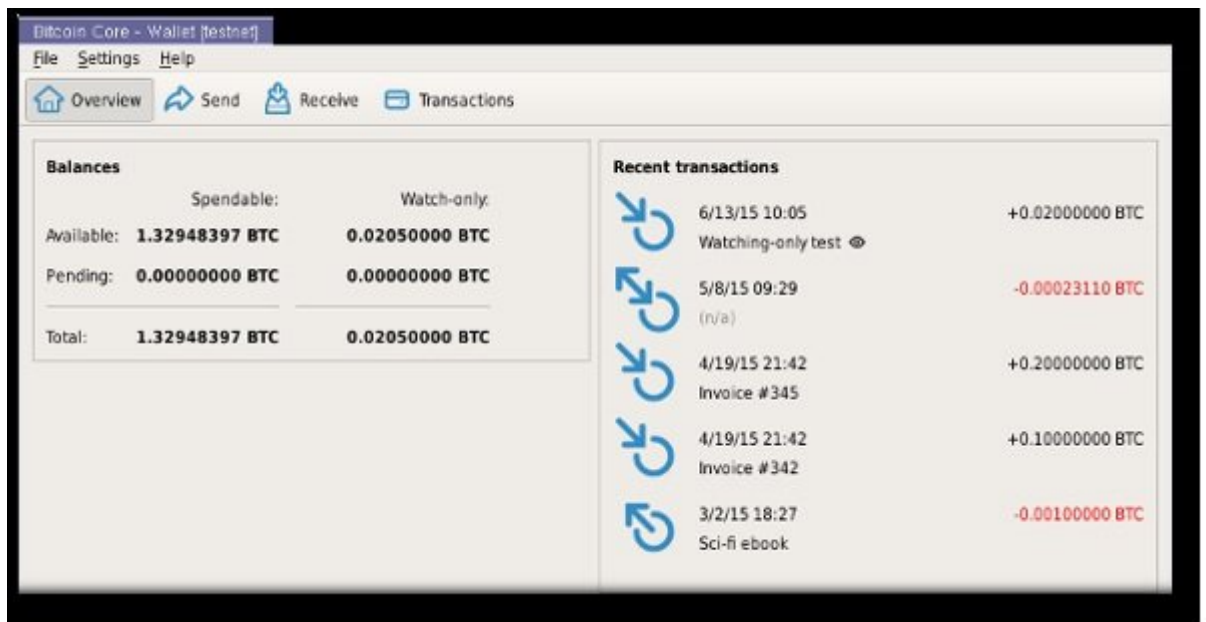
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Bitcoin Core wallet is a software application that manages your Bitcoin. It stores your private keys, which are used to sign transactions and prove ownership of your Bitcoin. It also manages your transaction history and provides a user interface for sending and receiving Bitcoin. [Nimiq](#) is a blockchain-based cryptocurrency that uses a proof-of-work consensus mechanism. It is designed to be a fast and efficient alternative to Bitcoin. Nimiq uses a different consensus mechanism called "Proof of Service" (PoS). This means that users are rewarded for providing services to the network, rather than for mining. Nimiq also features a built-in WebRTC and WebSocket interface, which allows for peer-to-peer communication between nodes. This makes the network more decentralized and resistant to censorship. Nimiq is currently in development and is not yet ready for widespread use. However, it has the potential to become a major player in the cryptocurrency market. It is designed to be user-friendly and secure. Exodus uses a hardware wallet to store your private keys, which makes it more secure than software wallets. Exodus also features a built-in exchange, which allows you to buy and sell cryptocurrencies directly from the wallet.
