RAID 0 (Striping) is a data storage configuration that uses multiple disks to store data in parallel. It is the fastest RAID configuration, but it does not provide any redundancy. If one disk fails, all data is lost. RAID 0 is best suited for applications that require high performance and can tolerate data loss.
